The decisions made by the judges are final and will not be open for negotiation; 9) The essays (and author names) may be displayed online for viewing by other entrants, parents/guardians, school staff and members of the public 10) Photos of winners and/or other entrants may be taken and utilised by Rotary for publicity purposes in the future.
